The Florida landscape is spinkled with 10,000 lakes ranging in size up to the 450,000 acre Lake Okeechobee.

There are over 1,000 golf courses.

Florida is top US producer for the following crops oranges, tomatoes, suger cane, grapefruit, green peppers, ferns, cucumbers, sweet corn, snap beans, water melon, tangerines, squash, radishes, gladioli and tangelos.

There are more than 14,000 citrus growers cultivating some 92 million citrus trees on over 791,000 acres.

More that 90% of Florida's oranges are processed for orange juice - almost 800 million US gallons.
