THE SILLY SEASON

Apart from Ascot, Henley, Glyndebourne, Traction Engine rallies and throwing the wellington boot the summer months bring a number of truly off beat activities in the United Kingdom. For example there is:-

NATIONAL BIRDMAN COMPETITION (Eastbourne - August). Every year competitors launch themselves from Eastbourne pier, attempting to fly using their own power and ingenuity. First prize of £1000 is awarded for technical originality and distance flown and £500 given for the best costume.

GUT BARGING (Bradford-on-Avon - August) Contestants strip to the waist and meet man to man in a specially constructed ring. The object is to barge your opponent from the ring using only your stomach.

WORM CHARMING (Cheshire - June). In the World Worm Charming Championships contestants working in two's compete to lure as many worms as possible from the ground in 30 minutes.

INTERNATIONAL BRICK AND ROLLING PIN THROWING CONTEST (Gloucestershire - July) This is a pure distance throwing event with the men hurling bricks and the ladies rolling pins.

BOG SNORKLING (Powys - August). Every year some 30 contestants put on snorkel and flippers and 'swim' two 60 yard lengths of a bog. Very difficult if there has been no rain for a spell.

CONKERING (Cambridgeshire - October). Some 300 contestants from France, Germany and America travel to the UK to compete in this event. About 1000 conkers are supplied by the organisers (to avoid cheating).

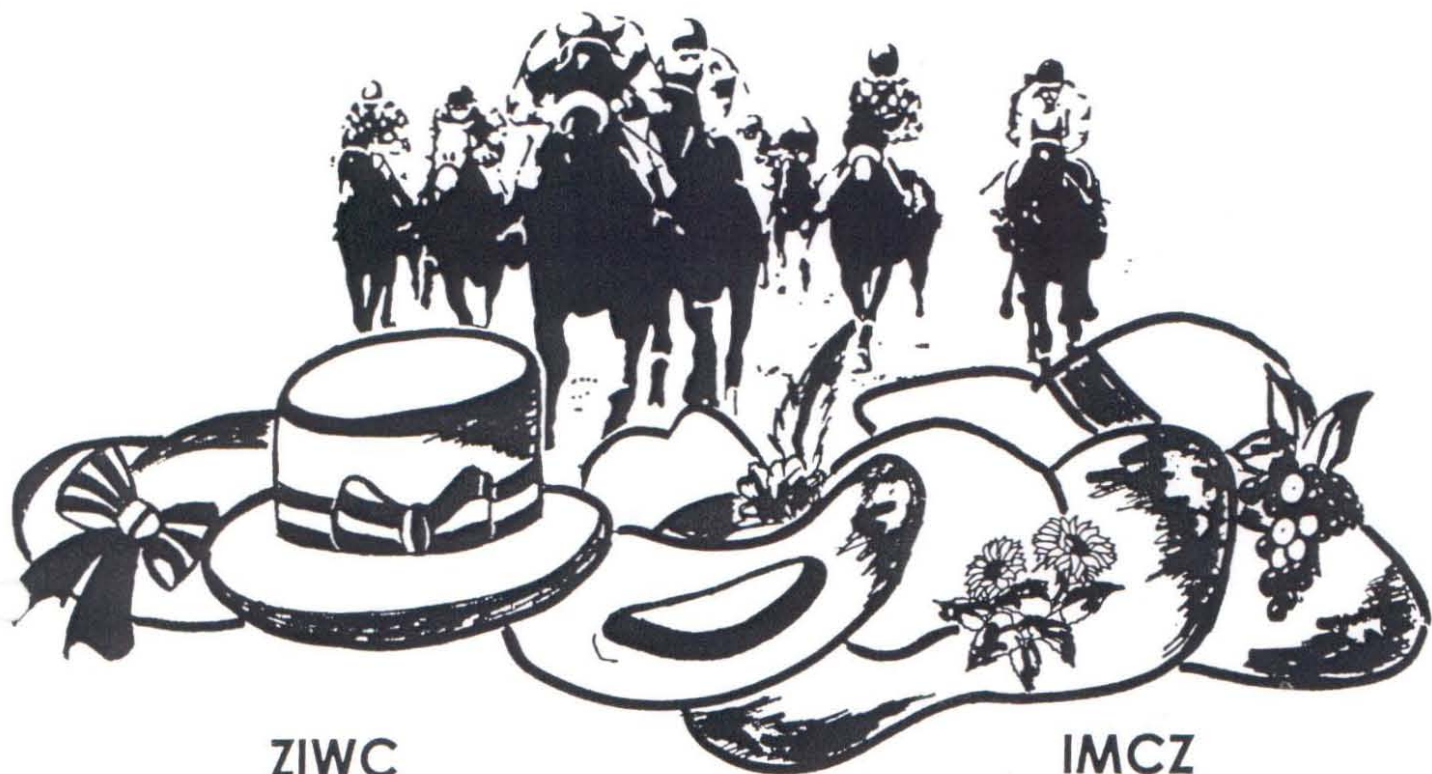
PEASHOOTING (Cambridgeshire - July). Competing in four categories (ladies, children, open and team) contestants stand 12ft (3.65m) from a target smeared with wet putty.

SNAIL RACING (Norfolk - July). Some 150 international snails 'race' over a 13in (330mm) course, from the centre of a circle to the perimeter.

TOE WRESTLING (Staffordshire - June). This is the equivalent of arm wrestling but using the toes. This 'sport' has been traced back to ancient Greece.

IRON BALL THROWING (Armagh - August). Here contestants hurl an iron ball along 2 miles of the cities
