## VISIT TO THE TOTAL ENERGY SYSTEM CHAM

This was a most interesting visit to an innovative district heating system - the only one of its type in Switzerland. Our host for the evening was Jules PIKALI of the WWZ.

Developed by the Wasserwerke Zug AG (WWZ) this is a district heating system featuring a cogeneration plant combined with a water-to-water heat pump using the River Lorze as both a hot and a cold source.

The so called Total Energy System consists of:-

1. a 543kW Otto gas engine with three way catalytic converter
2. a 187 kW electric generator
3. a 243 kW thermal output water-to-water heat pump
4. a dual fuel (gas and oil) boiler with low NOx burners

The system is totally automatic but can be manually controlled on-site or remotely controlled from the WWZ in Zug.

Currently the development consists of commercial and industrial buildings, a terraced five apartment house, the library, the Lorzensaal and a hotel and restaurant. In addition to the present system it is planned to take waste heat from the new X-Ray Institute and to provide services to the Badmatt residential complex and the Mandelhof municipal buildings.

After the presentation the party retired to the Milchsüdi restaurant - a restaurant to be recommended.

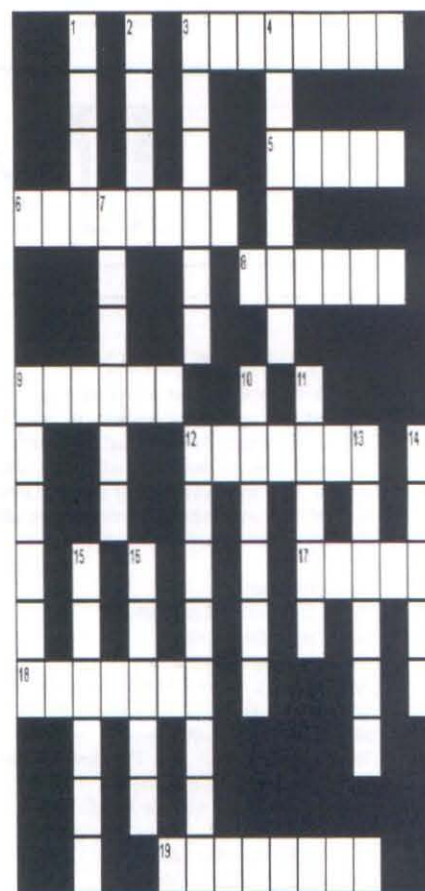

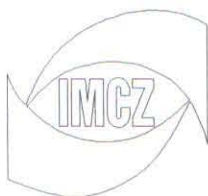
