ADVANCE TECHNOLOGY

The famous 24 hour Le Mans motor race was held on the 17/18 of June and for the first time in 50 years Cadillac was there with a team of cars.

The interesting part about this exercise was the GM website—www.gm.com—once logged on not only was it possible to get continuous updates of the race itself but you could also follow each of the Cadillac cars around the circuit and monitor engine data.
