TALKS ABOUT THE AVALANCHE WARNING SYSTEM IN THE SWISS ALPS

When the first skiers arrive early morning at the bottom of the ski lifts ready for a days skiing, the regional avalanche bulletins have already been published and are available to all ski resorts. Over the past five years the Intercantonal Measurement & Information System (IMIS) has been built and installed by Markusub AG. Weather and snow data from more than 100 stations in the Swiss Alps is transferred every hour to the Snow & Avalanche Research Centre Davos (SLF). Over 200 organisations, including weather and avalanche forecasters, have access to the measured and modelled data. This essential and critical information enables local authorities to make decisions concerning our safety—if areas are to be evacuated or roads closed.

Markusub AG, based in Olten, are suppliers of measuring systems for air, earth and water.
