Members were also introduced to the 'Cercle de Patronage du Mas Pigné' where investors help build up the quality of new wines being paid back with a share of the profits.

The discussion on wines continued over dinner with 'Mas Pigné' wines being served at the table.

SWISS BIG DIG

The NEW Gotthard rail tunnel, scheduled to be completed in 2012, will employ some 2500 international workers. With a length of 57 km it will exceed the existing worlds longest by 3 km. For more information about this project and to follow its construction go to: -
