IMCZ VISIT TO THE WALCHWIL FISH HATCHERY

**WEDNESDAY 21 MARCH 2001
MEET 18.50 hrs TOUR STARTS 19.00 hrs**

The Walchwil Fish Hatchery was originally opened in 1898 by the Walchwil Fishing Company at a cost of Sfr 16,000. By 1910 there were three hatcheries on the Lake of Zug, one still remains in Zug old town.

In 1999 the new extended, state of the art buildings in Walchwil were completed and became operational.

The overall budget for the project was Sfr 3.5M. The purpose of the hatchery is to ensure a sufficient replenishment of fish stocks in the lake to support the fishing business. Even with advances in genetic cloning the hatchery is dedicated to the continuation of fish stocks in the conventional manner.

The fish hatched in Walchwil are mostly Trout, Pike and Felchen.

The tour takes approx one hour and will be in German, hopefully one of our members will translate for those few not proficient in the language.

There will be an optional dinner afterwards at the Lido Restaurant. Please make your reservation to John STUART as per the enclosed registration sheet.
