From Zug drive to Unterägeri. Almost opposite the Police Station, turn right into Neushellstr, at the signpost indicating Hèrital (on the same signpost are signs for Altersheim and Gewebzone).

Drive on until you reach the Zugerbergstr and turn right.

Continue driving until you are within sight of the LandgasthofSchutzen and a 40kph/PRIVATE sign.

This is the junction of four small roads—you want the middle road of the three facing you.

From this point on look for IMCZ signs, at the roadside, leading you to the Waldhutte.
