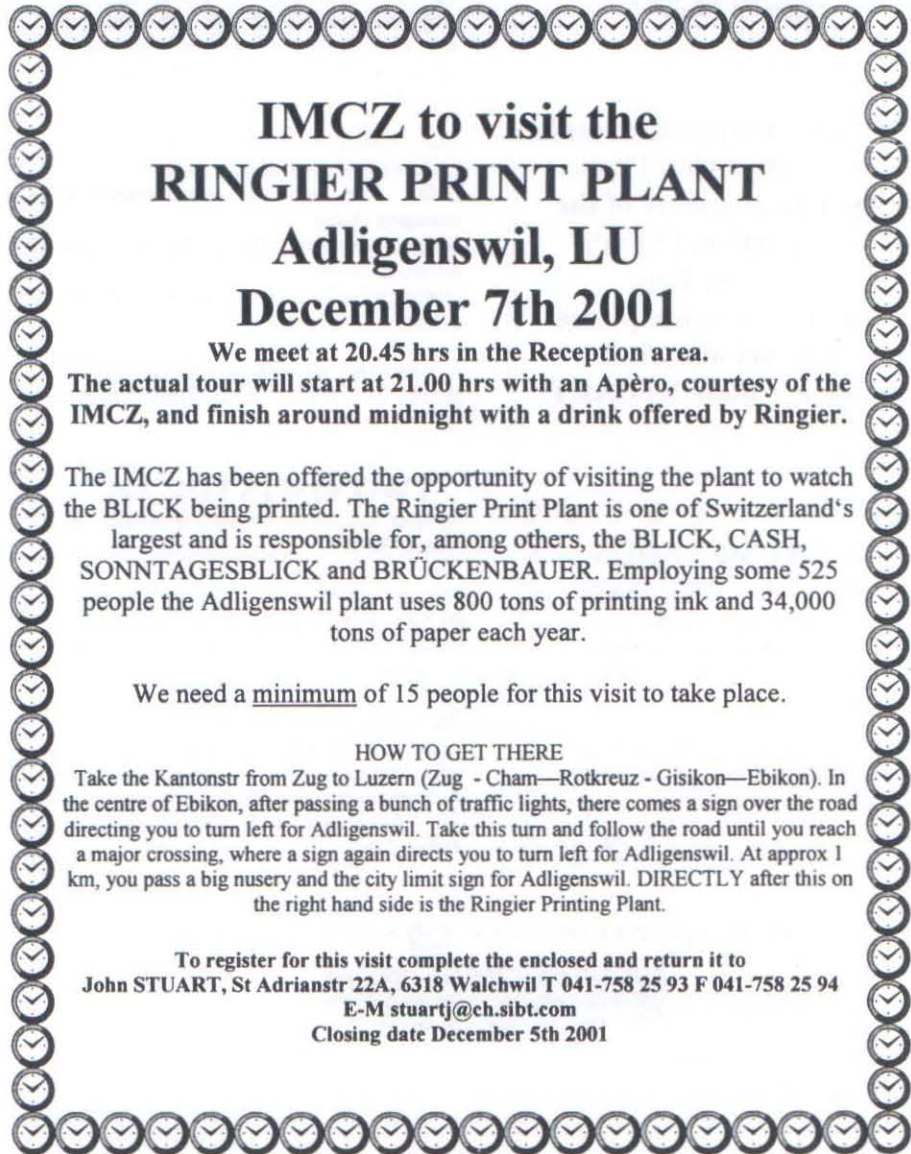

**IMCZ to visit the
RINGIER PRINT PLANT
Adligenswil, LU
December 7th 2001**

We meet at 20.45 hrs in the Reception area.

The actual tour will start at 21.00 hrs with an Apéro, courtesy of the IMCZ, and finish around midnight with a drink offered by Ringier.

The IMCZ has been offered the opportunity of visiting the plant to watch the BLICK being printed. The Ringier Print Plant is one of Switzerland's largest and is responsible for, among others, the BLICK, CASH, SONNTAGESBLICK and BRÜCKENBAUER. Employing some 525 people the Adligenswil plant uses 800 tons of printing ink and 34,000 tons of paper each year.

We need a minimum of 15 people for this visit to take place.

HOW TO GET THERE

Take the Kantonstr from Zug to Luzern (Zug - Cham—Rotkreuz - Gisikon—Ebikon). In the centre of Ebikon, after passing a bunch of traffic lights, there comes a sign over the road directing you to turn left for Adligenswil. Take this turn and follow the road until you reach a major crossing, where a sign again directs you to turn left for Adligenswil. At approx 1 km, you pass a big nursery and the city limit sign for Adligenswil. DIRECTLY after this on the right hand side is the Ringier Printing Plant.
