The very first Burns Supper took place over 200 years ago in an Alloway inn, in Ayrshire on the west coast of Scotland. Robert Burns and nine of his friends mused on the issues of the day, ate, drank and were merry, no doubt. Such gatherings have spread dramatically since, with suppers being held at this time of year across all five continents to celebrate the life and work of Robert Burns. In keeping with many others, the **International Men's Club of Zug** is proud to maintain this tradition by holding it's own Burns Supper in memory of Scotland's national bard.

The usual ingredients will be on offer to satisfy the most demanding of culture seekers and those who just want a good night out in pleasurable company.
