Visit to a special exhibition on
CRYPTOLOGY in the
Transport Museum Luzern

Friday 14 MARCH 2003 16.00 HRS

In 2002, Crypto AG, Steinhausen, celebrated its 50th birthday with a special exhibition in the Transport Museum, Luzern. Extensive documentation is shown covering the history of cryptology and the machines used, many of which have been produced by CRYPTO AG.

CRYPTO AG was founded by a Swede, Boris Hagelin. He developed an alternative to the German Enigma machine and offered this to the USA just before the second World War. A total of 14,000 machines were produced until the end of the war. After the war, CRYPTO AG established manufacturing facilities in Switzerland.

Basically CRYPTO only deals with governments leaving their fully owned sister company, INFOGUARD AG, to deal with industry and individuals.

INFOGUARD AG now kindly offers to lead the IMCZ through the highly interesting exhibition in the Luzern Transport Museum and give us an insight into the world of cryptology.

She became famous as the first German speaking author of a European-Monetary-System study and her European fund was voted Nr. 1 in 1998 (best average performance over five years). Gabriele has been head of the European Equity Fund team at Julius Baer Asset Management before joining GOODINVEST AG.

Switzerland, where mountains as high as 4630m cover 40% of the country, has a well established, private, professional air rescue and air ambulance organisation which serves almost 10,000 patients a year.

REGA use a mixed fleet of fully equipped helicopters and fixed wing aircraft for emergency medical services.

Trapped or injured mountaineers, road traffic victims, emergency hospital transfer patients and urgent donor organ transfer. REGA members taken ill abroad are flown home. The list doesn't stop there, during the summer months REGA also handles animal rescue operations

REGA'S headquarters, just north of the threshold of runway 28, overlooks all the facilities of Zürich Airport from the midfield terminal southwards.

REGA is an abbreviation made up of the first two letters of the German *Rettungsflugwacht* (air rescue guard) and the French *garde aérienne* (air guard).

The story is far more than can be told here—join us for the visit for the full facts of this incredible and very necessary organisation.

Plans to meet and go by train didnt work out but full instructions on how to find REGA are given on the separate. If you are travelling by car please be aware that traffic conditions at that time of the evening can be heavy.

We are further advised that you do not take the usual airport turn off but the next signposted Kloten-Sud—SEE THE ENCLOSED MAP.
