New Swiss Driver's Licence

As of April 1st, drivers have the opportunity to have a credit-card style driver's licence instead of the current blue paper one.

The new license no longer contains the driver's address, only the Canton. This means that, should the address change, there is no need to renew the license.

The format of the new license follows that of the EU bringing a bit more harmonisation to our European documents.

Naturally, the new license has to be paid for and in Canton Zug the charge will be CHF 60.-
