Top Secret Military Museum **Saturday, 10th July 2004 at 10:30am** **Festungsmuseum, Reuenthal**

On **Saturday July 10**, we are organising a guided tour of the Fortress Reuenthal near Koblenz. The fortress was built in 1938 and had the task of helping to prevent a crossing of the Rhine by German troops in the region of the Weir of Albrbruck. It was equipped with two 7.5 cm cannons and heavy machine guns. After World War II it lost significance in the light of rapid new developments in military tactics.

After 1988 the fortress was de-commissioned and a private association converted it into a museum with it's original armaments, equipment and quarters for 159 men. In some of the chambers, more than 200m inside the mountain, a very interesting exhibition of weapons and equipment of the Swiss and several other armies from the days of WW II is housed.

In the cosy little restaurant deep inside the fortress we have the opportunity to have lunch, military style—"Spatz aus der Gamelle"

We will meet at the entrance to the fortress some 250m from the car park at **10:30am**. The drive from Zug is **approx 75Km**, so you should allow at least **90 minutes** for the journey. (i.e. leave Zug **before 9:00 am**)

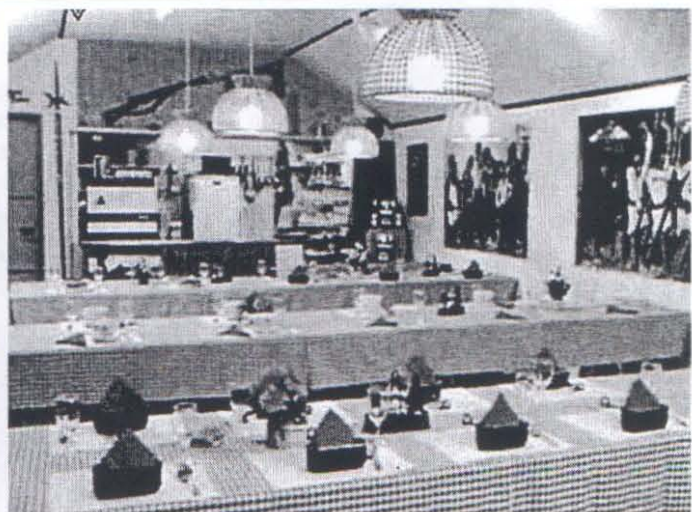
Total cost will be **CHF 25.-** per person and this includes entrance fee, lunch and drinks.

Directions: Zug—Wohlen—Lenzburg—Brugg—Koblenz

In Koblenz, cross the river Aare in the direction Basel. After approx. 2Km turn left to Reuenthal. Drive through the village and the car park is signposted on the left. Walk back to the small church and the fortress is signposted behind the church.
