Aircraft Museum, Dübendorf **Saturday, 23rd April 2005 at 10:00 am.**

We are very pleased to have arranged a visit to the Aircraft Museum in Dübendorf. The museum is headquartered on the existing air force base. It was established in 1972 and, since then, the exhibits have been continuously expanded. The present hall containing the aircraft is 4'000 m2 and was opened to the public in 2002.

The museum charts the history of the Swiss Air Force and anti-aircraft defence systems. As well as the fantastic display of aeroplanes there is also a gallery from where you can take a look at today's world of flying in the form of the military airbase site spread out before you like a stage! From there you can see fighter jets and other planes landing and taking off.

There will be a limit of 15 people for the tour so please book early!!

The train journey from Zug varies from 40-55 minutes so, hopefully, we can all meet up at Zug Bahnhof. Those who register will be informed.

There is also enough parking space available for those who wish to come by car. More information is on their web site at www.airfocecenter.ch.

Restaurant "Holding", is also at the location, looking out over the museum.

The day menu is between CHF 19,- and 22,-.

If they wish, people can lunch together after the guided tour.

Report on Kriminal Museum visit

On March 12th a hardy bunch of members and guests braved the wintry conditions and headed into Zürich for a visit to the Kriminal Museum. We had been told that some parts of the display would be pretty frightening but none of us were really prepared for what was in store.

The visit started with a fascinating history of the Zürich Police force; how it started and how it developed into the force it is today. There were hundreds of exhibits ranging from police weaponry, both old and new, to actual weapons confiscated from the criminal element of Zürich.

There then followed quite graphic descriptions of the various police work including burglary where the actual bank safes that had been robbed were on display. The counterfeit section was fascinating and, in some cases it was almost impossible to tell the fake money from the real stuff. Zürich also has it's fair share of murders and other shady goings-on and this was where the visit took on a more solemn mood. It reminded us all that, even here in Switzerland, the criminal element is always at work. All in all it was a great day out.
