To save the club postage the board has decided to only send the Newsletter by post to those members who do not have e-mail.

If you have an e-mail address and haven't already done so, please go to our web site and register for the Newsletter by e-mail.

Use **Member login** (if you have no password, one will be sent to you) and the first screen asks if you want the Newsletter by e-mail. Click on it and, hey presto, it's done.
