New Board Members

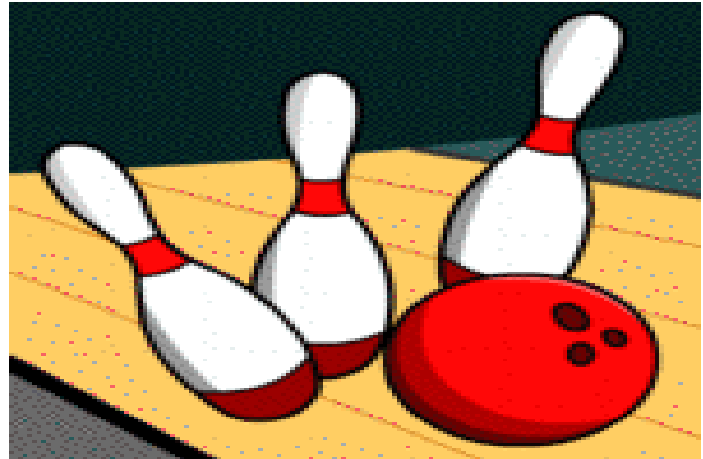
We are looking for nominations for new board members. Our AGM will be held in February and we'd like to propose a few names for election to the board.

Alpaca Wool

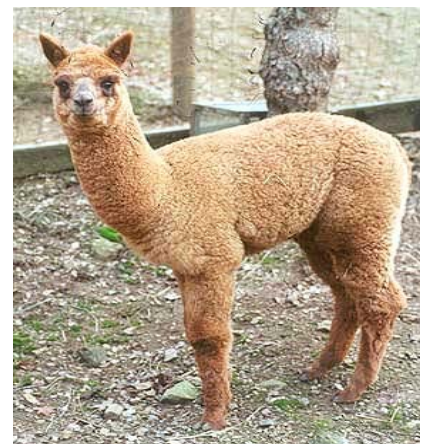
Winter is drawing near and maybe time to think of winter clothes. Why not try something different.
