Visit to the Monastery in Einsiedeln

Saturday 18th March 2006
Guided tour in English at **14:00 till 16:00**



IMCZ have booked a guided tour in English through one of the most beautiful and spectacular baroque churches in Europe; the famous **Einsiedeln Monastery** which dates back to the **9th century**.

As well as the church we will be guided through the library and the great hall (which houses a museum of old musical instruments) and the famous horse stables. The tour has been booked from 14.00 to 16.00 hours.

Members and guests should meet at **13:45** outside the main gate of the church. Parking is available in the park garage just to the left of the church. Einsiedeln is also reachable by public transport but the journey from Zug is cumbersome (SBB to Arth-Goldau, then by SOB to Biberbrugg, change for Einsiedeln and another 10 minutes to the church on foot).

After the tour IMCZ will offer an apéro in one of the restaurants in the village. The charge for our members and guests will be **CHF 10.-** for adults and **CHF 5.-** for children. I think you'll agree it's a great price for a great afternoon.
