## Report on the visit to Emmi

17 members of the IMCZ were treated to a fascinating presentation and tour by Herr Evers (manager of the Emmi logistics group). The visit began with a company presentation which turned into a very interesting discussion on the dairy products business. Some of the information revealed that..

- the marketing budget of CHF 60 mio. which was justified by the need not simply to produce but more importantly to actually sell the products in an increasingly brand-name conscious market
- the Emmi company is still 54% owned by farmers.
- the CHF 8 mio. marketing budget supporting Tom Luthi racing efforts in Spain
- that a price increase of 1-2 rappen per litre of milk would destroy their 2% net profit margin and the continual balancing act they have as a farmer dominated company and the desire to raise farmer incomes
- the brand new fully automated warehousing facility was impressive as also the inclusion of windows to enhance working conditions for their staff

The Presentation under the cheesy ceiling

- how Emmi is moving production into other European countries in order to compete as cheaper non-domestic milk cannot be imported
- was interesting to note that they produce many products for Coop & Migros despite the fact that these retailers also have their own production facilities
- that they have 27 trucks of their own which cover about a third of their logistical needs and than nothing whatsoever is moved by train as it is too expensive
- that 25% of revenues are already earned abroad and how this is expected to rise
- how, coming out, one appreciates an office job compared to the noise and/or cold conditions under which most of their staff work
- Emmi's skill in concluding company takeovers within 2 weeks! That in the latest company taken over the input has already doubled
- that in takeovers management staff is not acquired, only the production staff, in order to impose an homogenous culture in all the various entities

Despite the chilly conditions it was fascinating to see the different machines used for filling, labelling and packaging the products.

Our thanks go to Mr. Evers for making our tour so interesting.
