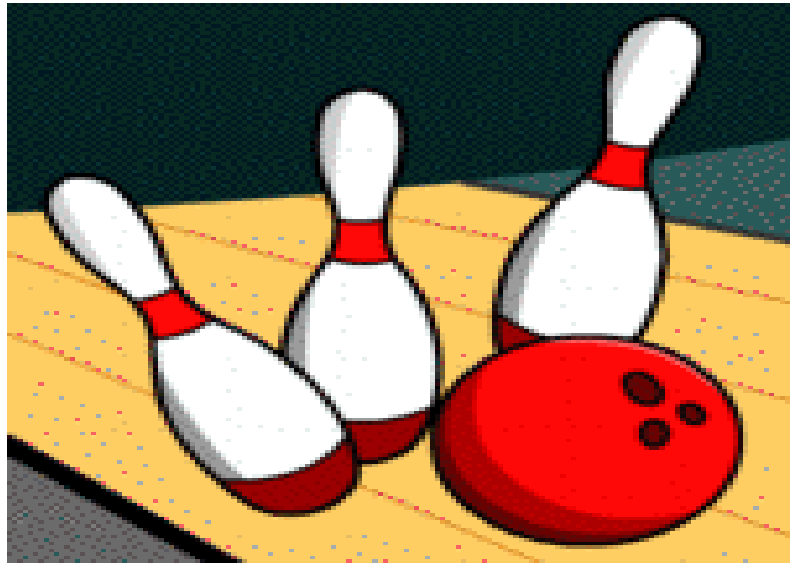
Annual General Meeting

It's also an evening where you can bring along some friends and introduce them to the club. If they can bowl that would be a bonus.

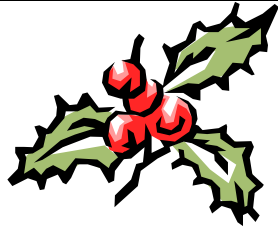
