In May of this year, the IMCZ organized a very popular tour of the Eichhof Brewery in Lucerne. If you couldn't make it, here's your chance to see what you missed!

The Zug International Women's Club (ZIWC) is organizing a tour of the Eichhof Brewery on Tuesday, November 20th at 10:30. The ZIWC has very kindly extended an invitation to IMCZ members to attend the tour. The tour begins with a 10 minute presentation followed by a 90 minute tour of the brewery. After the tour there will of course be the opportunity to sample the brewery's wares together with a light lunch of Fleischkäse, potato salad and bread.

The price of the tour is CHF 15.- per person – correct change preferred – and includes the tour as well as lunch and beer tasting afterwards.

If you are traveling by car, there is a parking structure across from the brewery. If you are traveling by train from Zug, take the 9:29 from Zug to Lucerne and then one of the following buses - #1, 11 or 20 – for roughly 7 minutes to the "Eichhof" stop.
